**All tuition fees, financing fees, deposits and/or monthly payments are non-refundable.**

## New Enrollments:

- **Admission fee:** A one-time admission fee of \$1,000 is due upon enrollment of your first child and \$500 for each subsequent student.
- **A one-time Bond** of \$2,500 per student to a maximum of \$5,000 per family is required for all new students. The bond must be paid on September 1 and will be refunded in the month of November following the student's departure from the school, provided the student has completed Grade 1. Any outstanding fees will be deducted from this bond. If a student withdraws before the end of the Grade 1 program, the school will retain the bond.

## Foreign students:

- Foreign students residing in Canada by virtue of a student visa are not eligible for the Alberta Subsidy for Resident Students. Consequently, these students must assume the total cost of education, an additional \$5,000 per year.

## Multi child discount

- Third and subsequent student(s) will receive a \$500 discount each towards 2018-2019 tuition fees.

## School Supplies

- All school supplies are included in the cost of tuition. Laptops are provided to students in Grades 9 to 12. They belong to the Lycée Louis Pasteur and are to be returned at the end of each school year.

## Field Trips

- Tuition fees include most field trips. Some field trips (i.e. overnight outings and out-of-province trips) will require additional costs.



### **Parent Participation Program**

- Our Parent Participation Program offers parents an opportunity to participate in school life. All families are required to contribute volunteer time to the school as follows:
  - One child: 12 hours or \$200 annually
  - Two children: 21 hours or \$350 annually
  - Three or more children: 24 hours or \$400 annually
