All tuition fees, financing fees, deposits and/or monthly payments are non-refundable.

New Enrollments:

- **Enrollment fee:** \$4,000 for the 1st student enrolled, \$3,500 for the 2nd child. The enrollment for the 3rd and subsequent students enrolled are waived.

Foreign students:

- Foreign students residing in Canada by virtue of a student visa are not eligible for the Alberta Subsidy for Resident Students. Consequently, these students must assume the total cost of education, an additional \$5,000 per year.

Multi child discount

- Third and subsequent student(s) will receive a \$500 discount each towards 2020-2021 tuition fees.

School Supplies

- All school supplies are included in the cost of tuition. Laptops are provided to students in Grades 9 to 12. They belong to the Lycée Louis Pasteur and are to be returned at the end of each school year.

Field Trips

- Tuition fees include most field trips. Some field trips (i.e. overnight outings and out-of-province trips) will require additional costs.

Parent Participation Program

- Our Parent Participation Program offers parents an opportunity to participate in school life. All families are required to contribute volunteer time to the school as follows:
 - One child: 12 hours or \$200 annually
 - Two children: 21 hours or \$350 annually
 - Three or more children: 24 hours or \$400 annually
