Our story so far

Lycée international de Calgary stands as a pioneer of French education and academic excellence in Alberta.

Our journey began in 1966 as Lycée Louis Pasteur, establishing us as one of Calgary's most enduring independent schools. While our roots are local, our vision has always been global.

This commitment to an international standard was solidified in 1990 when we joined the AEFÉ network, anchoring us within a prestigious community of over 600 schools across 140 countries. This partnership enables us to blend the rigorous French Ministry of Education curriculum with Alberta Education standards—creating a dual-track program with no equivalent in the province. We are the first and only school in Alberta where graduates earn both the French Baccalauréat and the Alberta High School Diploma.

Since moving to our Marda Loop home in 2000, we have continually evolved to meet the needs of our diverse community. Our evolution was marked by our rebranding to Lycée international de Calgary in 2021 and our physical expansion in January 2025, which added eight new classrooms and a dedicated gymnasium for our youngest learners. Today, from Preschool to Grade 12, we remain dedicated to a future-proof education that combines academic rigour with an authentic multicultural experience, cultivating citizens ready to shape the future.

Pillar 1

Championing Bilingual Excellence and Future-Ready Learning

We will pioneer authentic bilingual education by intentionally integrating our French and Alberta curricula, fostering multilingual literacy, and preparing every student to thrive in an evolving world. Our commitment is to ensure each graduate is a resilient, well-rounded individual ready to navigate the complexities of life and contribute to society with purpose.

INTEGRATING CURRICULA FOR GLOBAL READINESS

We will seamlessly integrate our Alberta and French curricula through intentional alignment and collaborative instruction. This ensures a single, high standard of academic excellence, preparing students for success in both systems.

ESTABLISH SEAMLESS DUAL CURRICULUM INTEGRATION:

We will align curricula by identifying overlapping competencies and establishing shared benchmarks. We will formalize dedicated co-planning time and invest in professional development to equip educators with innovative bilingual strategies that foster excellent proficiency from first leaps into preschool to beyond graduation.

ENHANCE MULTILINGUALISM AND CREDENTIALS:

We will formalize pathways for students to achieve recognized language certifications (e.g., DELF/DALF, DELE, IELTS) in French, English, and Spanish. We will also embed strategies to help students master the skills needed to excel in all standardized exams and post-secondary studies.



BUILDING RESILIENT LEARNERS FOR A COMPLEX WORLD

We will foster well-rounded student journeys by integrating social-emotional development and cultivating future-ready skills, preparing them to thrive and identify opportunities in fast-changing and interconnected societies.

CULTIVATE WELL-ROUNDED STUDENT SUCCESS:

We will strengthen wellness programming by expanding access to mental health resources and creating support networks that meet students' unique needs. We will also actively empower student voice and leadership to foster a greater sense of ownership and community pride.

PREPARE STUDENTS FOR A TECHNOLOGICALLY EVOLVING WORLD:

We will champion the responsible use of AI and emerging technologies. We will establish a progressive digital literacy curriculum, implement clear guidelines for ethical use, and expand project-based learning that challenges students to apply technology to solve real-world problems.

FORGING PATHWAYS FOR GLOBAL IMPACT

We will expand opportunities for hands-on learning, mentorship, and service-based initiatives. This will prepare our students to live our values with a sense of purpose and leadership.

We will establish a consistent annual giving program. By engaging families through educational and participatory opportunities, we will connect their philanthropic efforts directly to our mission and visibly recognize their contributions, reinforcing the collective impact of their support.

EXPANDING OUR INFLUENCE THROUGH STRATEGIC PARTNERSHIPS

We will expand and strengthen partnerships with the Francophone community, educational networks, and alumni, forging lasting connections for our students.

STRENGTHEN COMMUNITY AND ALUMNI CONNECTIONS:

We will establish a strategic partnership network with key Francophone organizations, the CAIS and AEFE networks, and other international institutions. We will create a formal alumni engagement program to foster a culture of lifelong connection and offer them meaningful ways to stay involved with their alma mater.

LEVERAGE LYCÉE'S AGILITY FOR INNOVATION:

We will use our small size and agility to drive innovation. We will create a cross-divisional innovation fund to provide seed money for collaborative projects and actively seek partnerships with external organizations and educational research groups to amplify our impact.

We will achieve ambitious and sustainable enrolment by retaining current students and strategically targeting new recruitment across all school levels. This ensures our students can thrive within our model of individualized attention.

ACHIEVE AMBITIOUS AND SUSTAINABLE ENROLMENT:

We will increase enrolment by 20% through strong retention, targeted recruitment, and expanded on-ramps. We will leverage student, alumni, and parent ambassadors to enhance outreach and optimize existing campus spaces to accommodate growth.

ENSURE PHYSICAL AND DIGITAL SAFETY:

We will conduct a full risk assessment and integrate security and safety improvements into our physical and digital infrastructures, ensuring a secure and modern learning environment for all.



SECURING FOUNDATIONAL CAPITAL INVESTMENT

We will transform our campus into a comprehensive facilities master plan and future-ready learning hub through a successful capital campaign.

DEVELOP A COMPREHENSIVE FACILITIES MASTER PLAN:

We will launch a feasibility study to assess outdoor space development and future campus use, creating a long-term plan to fund growth. We will develop a phased capital plan with clear timelines, cost estimates, and funding strategies for each project.

LAUNCH A SUCCESSFUL CAPITAL CAMPAIGN:

We will launch a capital campaign to secure the foundational investments needed to transform our campus and prudently rebuild a Board Reserve. We will design our campaign to foster a culture of broad-based investment, encouraging every family, alumni, and community member to contribute at a level meaningful to them.

DIVERSIFYING REVENUE FOR FINANCIAL RESILIENCE

We will secure our financial future by full cost capture and building the financial diversifying revenue streams to ensure agility required for long-term viability.

BUILD FINANCIAL AGILITY:

We will seek new revenue streams to serve our mission and the broader community. We will also conduct a full review of tuition and fee structures to ensure all services are fully covered and support our long-term viability.

DEVELOP ADVANCEMENT CAPACITY:

We will establish a dedicated advancement function responsible for creating and executing a multi-year plan that uses a comprehensive, multi-targeted approach to fundraising and community engagement.





The Path to the Plan

The development of IMPACT 2030 was a comprehensive journey designed to harness the collective wisdom of our community and secure the best possible future for Lycée international de Calgary.

The process was overseen by the Board of Directors, who remained actively engaged at every stage. To direct the work, we formed a diverse Steering Committee comprised of parents, staff and student representation, supported by the expert guidance of independent school consultants Ian Symmonds & Associates.

With a timeline spanning from January to September 2025, our strategy is grounded in extensive data. We began with a school-wide survey and in-depth market research, which formed the basis of a comprehensive SWOT analysis. Guided by the results of both the survey and the market analysis, the Steering Committee undertook the strategic work to define our direction. To ensure these goals resonated with our constituents, the committee led targeted focus groups, directly involving over 40 stakeholders in the reflective work to test and refine our strategic pillars.

The resulting plan, formally approved by the Board, is rigorous, data-driven, and inclusive. It reflects the aspirations of our entire community and carries the full commitment of our leadership.
